To: All Livestock Exhibitors, 4-H Leaders and Vo-Ag Instructors

County Fair Week – September 10-17

It's time to start planning for the 2016 White County Fair, which means setting up stall and coop space. The stall and coop space will be assigned by the superintendents as in the past. It is very important to get an accurate count of how many animals you will be bringing, so the superintendents can plan accordingly. **All animals including MARKET ANIMALS must be registered by the deadline of August 1st. There will be no entries accepted after the deadline.**

Online entries will be accepted starting July 1st – August 1st.

Online entries can be made at: whitecountyfairgrounds.org.

Entries can also be made by filling out the appropriate forms that can found on the website, at the Fair Office, and the Extension Office. All forms should be mailed to the **White County Fair Association, Post Office Box 1605, Searcy, AR 72145**. They must be post marked on or before August 1, 2016. A drop box will also be available at the fair office on the fairgrounds, if you prefer to drop off your forms. These will also be accepted July 1st – August 1st.

If not doing online entries please note, all exhibitors MUST fill out the Livestock Summary Form, (sign up for RV space is on this sheet). This form MUST accompany the other forms.

To satisfy the poultry requirements, set by the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission, Ruth Ann Evans will test chickens, turkeys and pigeons for exhibit from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 20 at the White County Fairgrounds. Waterfowl do NOT have to be tested. This is a state law and no poultry will be allowed on the fairgrounds without being tested prior to the fair.

If you know people interested in exhibiting at the fair who may have not received this letter please tell them to call the Extension Office to get information.
