#### FRAMED ART WORK

Exhibits including frame, may not be larger than 36"x27". All work must be dry, **framed**, and **substantially wired to hold weight of frame**. (No taped string or saw tooth hangers will be accepted). **Name, address, entry number, division, and class entering on back** of work in upper right hand corner (**USE YELLOW LABELS, PROVIDED. WRITE IN PENCIL ONLY**). **Entry number** needs to be **on front** of work in **lower right hand corner**. **Adults may enter two works but only one to a class and students may only enter one piece.**
