White County Fair AUTOCROSS RULES

Gates open at 3:00pm.

ENRTY FEE – Entry Fee is \$100 additional pit passes are \$30.00 per person 18 and older. Proper photo identification is required, if requested by fair officials.

NO ONE UNDER 18 WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PITS WITHOUT PROPER AUTHORIZATION.

Each car's entry fee gets you one derby car, one driver, one pit man, the tow vehicle and trailer hooked to that tow vehicle. If you have two cars on one trailer, then it gets just that one trailer and tow vehicle into the pits. Any vehicles bringing tools /jacks etc., will be allowed to drop off the tools and such then leave the pits and park in paid parking.

Each driver must be at least 16 years old with photo Identification and a parent present with a birth certificate for the driver.

- 1. Any 2wd make or model is allowed. No 4wd. No all wheel drives. Trucks, vans, and SUVs are allowed.
- 2. Vehicles can remain factory, with glass left in, interior, gas tank, can all remain in factory position. A HALO or ROLL-OVER BAR IS MANDATORY, and a safety cage around the driver and passenger area on the inside of the car is recommended. PLEASE PREPARE FOR A ROLL-OVER, because you never know.
- 3. If the vehicle is altered, (other than the safety bar and cage) it should follow the derby car build rules for the class a driver intends to participate in. Age restrictions applies to drivers and pit entry during events.
- 4. 1 passenger will be allowed.
- 5. Direction of travel will be decided before the start of EACH race.
- 6. Vehicles will be separated into classes; v8 class, 6 cylinder, and 4 cylinder classes.
- 7. Prize money is as follows:

Thursday night

\$600 -1st

\$400 -2nd

\$200 -3rd

Friday night

Each cylinder class

\$600 -1st

\$400 -2nd

\$200 -3rd

8. This is an aggressive dirt track race, the "bump and run" move will be tolerated, and GENTLE bumping and pushing will be allowed. However, THIS IS NOT A DEMOLITION DERBY. DO NOT TREAT IT AS SUCH.

9. White Co. Fair Motorsports officials will have the final say in all decisions and actions. It takes two judges for all disciplinary decisions. All other driver/pit crew rules, and track rules for the derby apply to this event.

Car count will decide how many heats we run.

Heat Race Starting order will be drawn at the drivers meeting, after we determine a car count. Feature race starting order will be determined by finishing order of your heat race(s).
