

JIM COLLINS MEMORIAL ALL-AROUND SHOWMANSHIP CHAMPIONSHIP

The Jim Collins Memorial Award was established to honor the memory of Jim Collins and his love for the youth of White County and his perennial contributions to the White County Fair Junior Market Animal Show and Sale.

The award will be given annually to the Champion All-Around Senior Livestock Showman. The winner will be selected from the Champion Senior Showman in each species of all livestock showmanship contests held at the White County Fair Livestock Shows.

The Champion Senior Showmanship exhibitor chosen from each species (beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goat, meat goat, sheep and swine) will bring their animal back to the show ring following the final species to show and then rotate exhibiting each of the other species of livestock for the judge.

The judge will then select the best all-around exhibitor from the individuals presenting.

The winner will receive a traveling trophy that will carry his/her name and year of the award, as well as a plaque for winning the overall showmanship award. The winner will bring the traveling trophy back the next year for presentation to the winner. He/she will keep the plaque for being the Champion All-Around Showmanship winner for that year.
